Education, Capacity building & Female Vocational Training: Iqra Primary Schools:

Non formal primary schools, Government approved syllabus, FREE education for deprived children, 35 students per teacher per class room. Low cost @ USD 3.5 per child per month. Leadership & ethics based programs inclusive. 140 schools currently operating at 15 zones of Pakistan. 70 schools are solar powered for continuous operations in all seasons. School can be opened in one week time by requesting our task team. Future Expansion Inshallah: 400 Schools in next 03 years in association with Diya Foundation.

Igra Plus Middle Schools for Girls & Vocational Training Center:

Generally, there is no culture of educating girls beyond primary level in rural areas. Kawish Launched 02 centers for 8th Grade schools with stitching classes. Under this project, girls of Iqra Plus schools and other women of villages are provided with much demanded skills like sewing and cutting of cloth, embroidery and quilt making etc.

Virtual Training of Teachers & Educators:

Kawish Welfare Trust's Education sector regularly conducts virtual training sessions on a monthly basis connecting 10 regional offices and more than 100 Teachers, Educators & Volunteers in an interactive session with philanthropists and experienced trainers.









Health Care Services: (Project Director for Health care: Mr. Aman Ullah Khan) Rural Telemedicine – Hub & Spoke Model:

Hub in Lahore:

Doctors at HUB or anywhere in the world can connect to any SPOKE for higher level of diagnostics. Significant features include; Video conferencing (2-way real time consultation), Electronic Medical Records (EMR) tool, application & archival for patients history.

Spoke:

08 Spokes have been established to provide health care in each school cluster in villages. They remain open for 03 hours (4pm⁻⁷pm) each to cater for 1000 patients per month (treatment & FREE issuance of medicines). Para medical staff including a dispenser, LHV and support staff are available for services in a comfortable environment. The diagnostics level at each Spoke is enhanced with the connectivity of specialist Doctors at Hub in Lahore via SKYPE for online consultation. Spoke is equipped with electronic medical diagnostics unit & ECG machine. BBC News covered Kawish Welfare Trust's RTM model in their report;

Gynea Section:

Gynea Section at each Spoke is to provide relief to the deprived female population at their doorsteps. Emergency patients are transported to nearest civil hospital by Kawish ambulance service in shortest possible time.

Micro-finance Project (Products & Goats):

Project was initiated by Kawish Welfare Trust in collaboration with Akhuwat in 2008. Under Micro-finance Project, we have distributed 10 motorcycles, more than 1000 bicycles and about 1200 sewing machines to the deserving persons on interest free, easy installment basis amounting to over Rs. 15 million. After successful implementation of product based micro-finance scheme, a livestock project was initiated in 2010 with a paid up capital of Rs. 3.7 million. Beneficiaries are the parents of poor students, orphans, widows and poor deserving villagers. We get back principal amount in 03 years. This project has brought self-esteem & self-sustainability to over 500 families.







Eye Surgery Project:

An operation theater with state-of-the-art equipment at a hospital in South Punjab for cataract eye surgeries. Eye camps are organized on a monthly basis and back-up support is given through weekly follow ups. Over 4500 surgeries have been safely conducted. We charge only Rs. 1000 for providing all services including surgical cost, logistics and overnight stay. Eye Outpatient Department (OPD) services are offered free to patients.



Ambulance Service at SPOKE:

06 ambulances have been provided in as many rural hospitals which are available 24 hours to handle emergency of any kind.



Hunarmand Entrepreneur Program: (Up to Rs. 5.0 million)

For graduates in rural areas, we have shortlisted young entrepreneurs and encouraged them to launch their own business by getting interest free loans upto Rs. 50,000 each & necessary guidance from seasoned staff of Kawish. They all are doing tremendously well and are now regularly paying back soft loan amount in installments.







Disaster Management:

During the last decade, Pakistan suffered from great natural disasters like Earthquakes, Floods & IDP's. Donors and associate organizations joined Kawish and extended their generous financial support during these disasters. Life-time amount spent (cash & in-kind) on relief & rehabilitation projects is estimated at Rs. 250 million.
